

## **Learning Outside The Classroom Outcomes for Teachers and Leaders**

Activity Team West Berkshire uses the following outcomes to help provide High Quality Outdoor Education. These have been produced by Learning Outside The Classroom as a benchmark to assist Teachers and Leaders who are assessing our work against the curriculum.

### **Outcomes:**

1. Enjoy participating in outdoor activities and adopt a positive attitude to challenge and adventure.
2. Gain personal confidence and self-esteem through taking on challenges and achieving success.
3. Develop their self-awareness and social skills, and appreciation of the contributions and achievements of themselves and of others.
4. Become aware of the natural environment and understand the importance of conservation and sustainable development.
5. Acquire and develop a range of skills in outdoor activities expeditions and exploration.
6. Demonstrate increased initiative, self-reliance, responsibility, perseverance and commitment.
7. Develop and extend their key skills of communication, problem solving, leadership and teamwork.
8. Learn to appreciate the benefits of physical fitness and the lifelong value of participation in healthy leisure activities.
9. Display an increased motivation and appetite for learning that contributes to raised levels of attainment in other aspects of their education
10. Broaden horizons and become open to a wider range of employment opportunities and life chances.

### **LOtC Quality Indicators**

These are the quality indicators that providers seeking the LOtC Badge must meet. They require that a provider:

1. Has a process in place to assist users to plan the learning experience effectively
2. Provides accurate information about its offer;
3. Provides activities, experience or resources which meet learner needs;
4. Reviews the experience and acts upon feedback;
5. Meets the needs of users; and
6. Has processes in place to manage risk and other liabilities effectively.
