

ROUTE 1

- 1 FACT FILE**
 Route Distance: 22 miles
 Grade: Hard
 Duration: 2 Hours
 Map required: OS Landranger 174
 Newbury and Wantage or OS Explorer 158 Newbury and Hungerford
 Terrain: Hilly
- 1 Start at Northcroft Leisure Centre, Newbury. Cycle up shared footway/cycleway to the left of Goldwell Park (in front of you if standing with the leisure centre behind you; northerly direction)
 - 2 Join Speen Lane at the top of the footway/cycleway. Ahead and to the R is Old Bath Road. Turn L along Old Bath Road.
 - 3 Follow this until the T-junction with Bath Road at which you need to turn L. **[A formal crossing facility is available – Use of this is advised.]** Take first R. Continue to T-junction.
 - 4 Turn R along Grove Road.
 - 5 At Roundabout turn L (Oxford Road, B4494) towards Wantage.
 - 6 At the Roundabout take 2nd exit towards M4, A34.
 - 7 After Donnington Valley Hotel and Golf Club, turn R, over A34, onto Curridge Road (signposted Curridge)
 - 8 Follow round to the R towards Curridge and Cold Ash.
 - 9 At Cross road continue forward on to Crab tree lane **[Unpaved track]**
 - 10 At T-junction turn L onto Priors Court road
 - 11 After Hillier Garden Centre turn R Signposted Care.
 - 12 Follow the road round, the road becomes Manor Lane **[the road becomes very narrow]**
 - 13 At T-junction turn L onto B4009 (Hampstead Norey's Road)
 - 14 Pass under M4, take first L, towards Bothamstead and Beedon.
 - 15 Pass under A34, at junction turn L (Signposted Newbury). At World's End.
 - 16 Turn R signposted Downend and Chieveley (Downend Road)
 - 17 At T-junction turn L, Signposted Chieveley and Newbury.
 - 18 At Chieveley, after the post office turn R onto School Road, Chieveley Primary School is on the R.
 - 19 Follow the road round to the L.

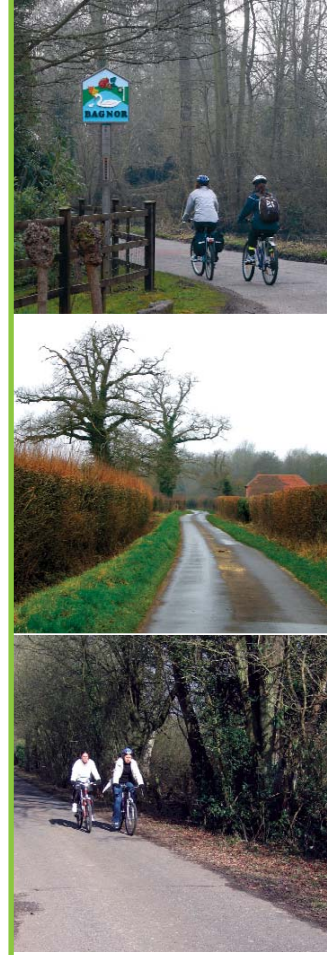
ROUTE 2

- 2 FACT FILE**
 Route Distance: 13 miles
 Grade: Fairly Hard
 Duration: 1 1/4 Hours
 Map required: OS Landranger 174
 Newbury and Wantage or OS Explorer 158 Newbury and Hungerford
 Terrain: Fairly Hilly
- 1 Start at Northcroft Leisure Centre, Newbury as per longer route
 - 2 Turn L along Grove Road.
 - 3 Road Passes under A34. Just After this, turn R signed towards Bagnor and the Watermill Theatre. **[Please be aware of the speed of traffic]**
 - 4 Pass the Watermill Theatre on LHS. Continue on around to the R **[Be aware of sand, soil and leaves along this track]**
 - 5 At Winterbourne. At T-junction turn L towards Chieveley and Hermitage on B4494.
 - 6 Continue under the M4 then turn L at cross roads, towards Boxford.
 - 7 Follow road to the L, towards Boxford
 - 8 At T-junction turn L, towards Boxford and Newbury
 - 9 Continue on the road around the bends, at T-junction turn L onto Lambourne Road (signposted Newbury) **[Steep narrow windy road]**
 - 10 Follow longer route.
 - 11 Start at Northcroft Leisure Centre, Newbury as per longer route
 - 12 Turn L heading back towards Northcroft Leisure Centre.
 - 13 Lane.
 - 14 Turn L onto Old Bath Road, and then R onto Speen
 - 15 Brumell Road,
 - 16 At junction turn L onto Grove Road, and then R onto
 - 17 Continue straight on through Winterbourne
 - 18 **[Be aware of sand, soil and leaves along this track]**
 - 19 Pass under M4, and turn R towards Winterbourne and Boxford.
 - 20 At T-junction turn L joining the B4494 towards Newbury, Winterbourne and Boxford.
 - 21 Pass under M4, and turn R towards Winterbourne and Boxford.
 - 22 Continue straight on through Winterbourne
 - 23 At junction turn L onto Grove Road, and then R onto
 - 24 Brumell Road,
 - 25 Turn L onto Old Bath Road, and then R onto Speen
 - 26 Lane.
 - 27 Turn L heading back towards Northcroft Leisure Centre.

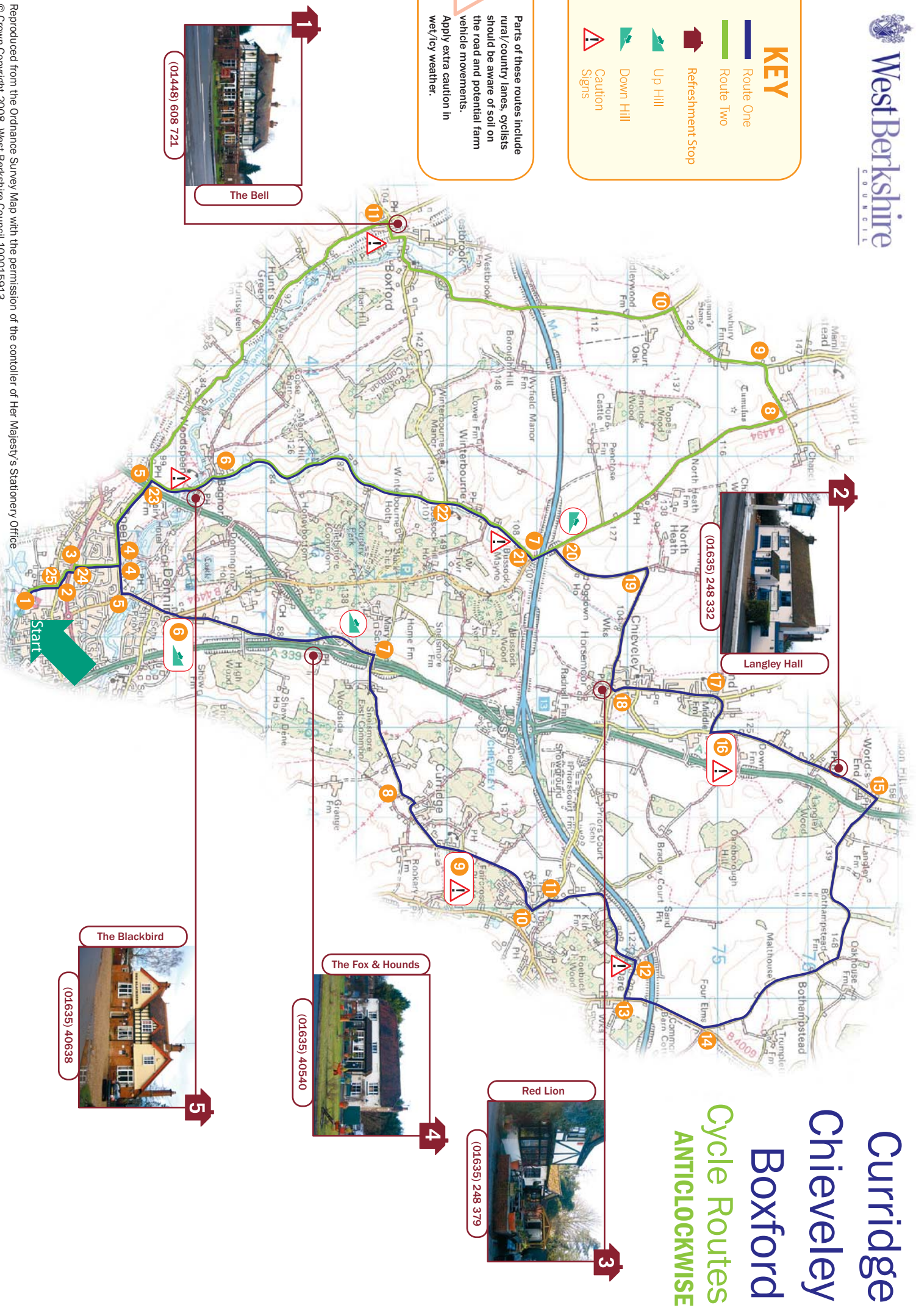


KEY
