Hambridge Road Carriageway Resurfacing

I am writing to inform you that West Berkshire Council's (WBC) term maintenance contractor Volker Highways has made significant progress in resurfacing of the A4 and are currently a number of days ahead of schedule. Therefore in order to maintain the current progress and utilise resources, the night time carriageway resurfacing of Hambridge Road is being brought forward and will now start on Monday 22nd June 2020 for four nights.

In order to safely undertake the works described above and to protect both the public and contractor, a full closure Hambridge Road is required.

Please see the table below which highlights the closure dates and access arrangements. The night closures are permitted between 19:00pm to 5:00am. A series of diversions will be in place and are highlighted on plans that accompany this letter.

Dates	Closure description
22nd June – 24th June 2020 Night working	<p>A4 Westbound inside lane closed only from Lower Way Junction to west of Hambridge Road junction. Traffic can still travel Westbound on the A4 but with reduced lanes.</p> <p>Hambridge Road closed from the A4 to Racecourse Roundabout.</p> <p>Access to Two Rivers Way will be via Hambridge Road, Racecourse Roundabout end.</p> <p>HGV access to Hambridge Road & Bone Lane will be via Mill Lane. Exit via Kings Road.</p>
25 th June 2020 Night working	<p>A4 closed Westbound from Tull Way Roundabout to B&Q Roundabout.</p> <p>A4 Eastbound outside lane closed only through Hambridge Road junction. Traffic can still travel Eastbound on the A4 but with reduced lanes.</p> <p>Hambridge Road closed from the A4 to Racecourse Roundabout.</p> <p>Access to Two Rivers Way will be via Hambridge Road, Racecourse Roundabout end.</p> <p>HGV access to Hambridge Road & Bone Lane will be via Mill Lane. Exit via Kings Road.</p>

NOTE – The dates shown above may change due to anything unforeseen arising or adverse conditions.

Access to residential dwellings within the closure area will be permitted at all times, although due to the nature of the works some inconvenience will be inevitable but we will endeavour to keep this to an absolute minimum.

Access for emergency services on a blue light will be permitted at all times.

Due to the current Covid-19 restrictions this letter will not be delivered to any residential dwellings or businesses but will be uploaded on to the scheme blog along with closure/diversion plans and information. Scheme information boards will be erected on all approaches informing the public of the upcoming works. The blog can be accessed here;

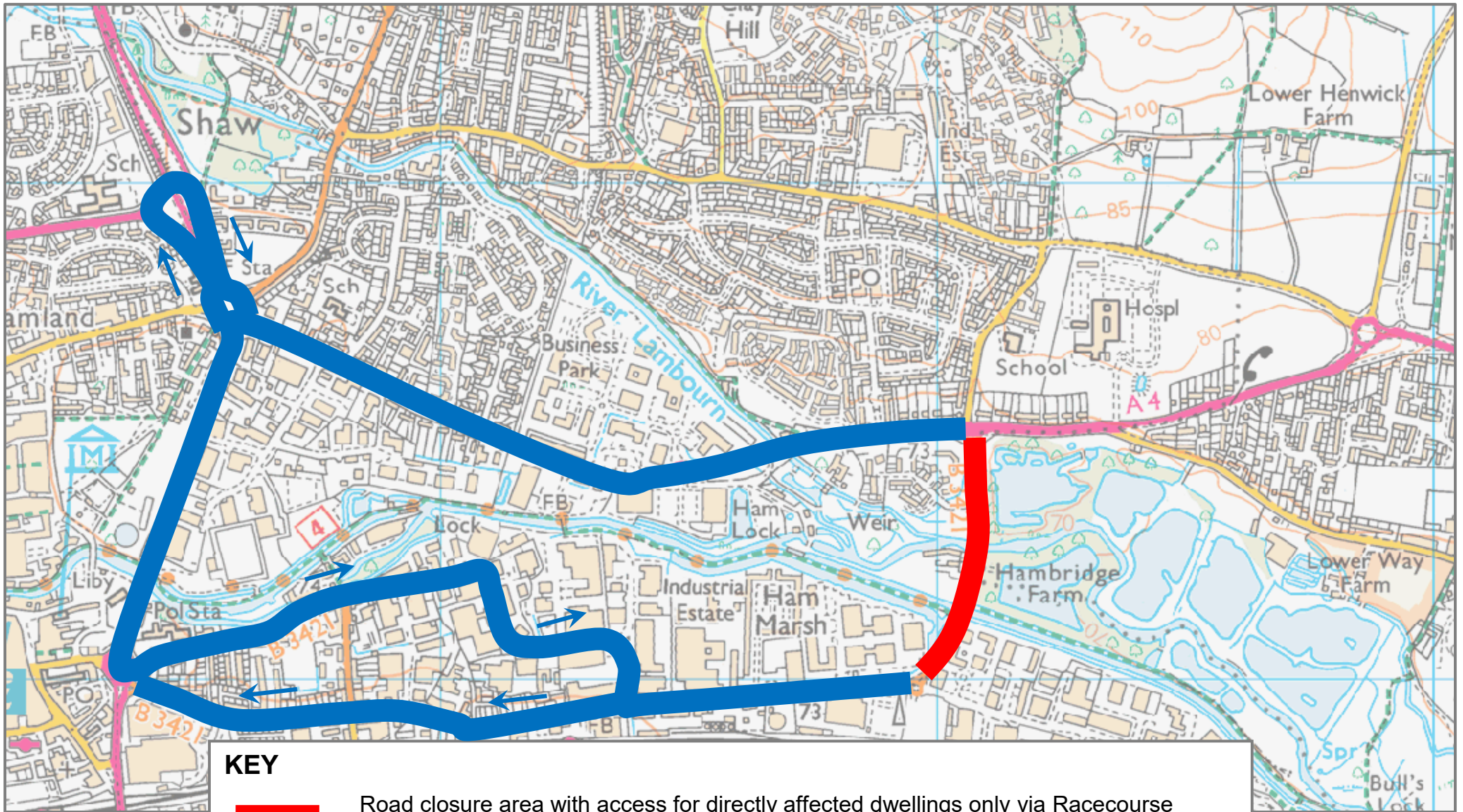

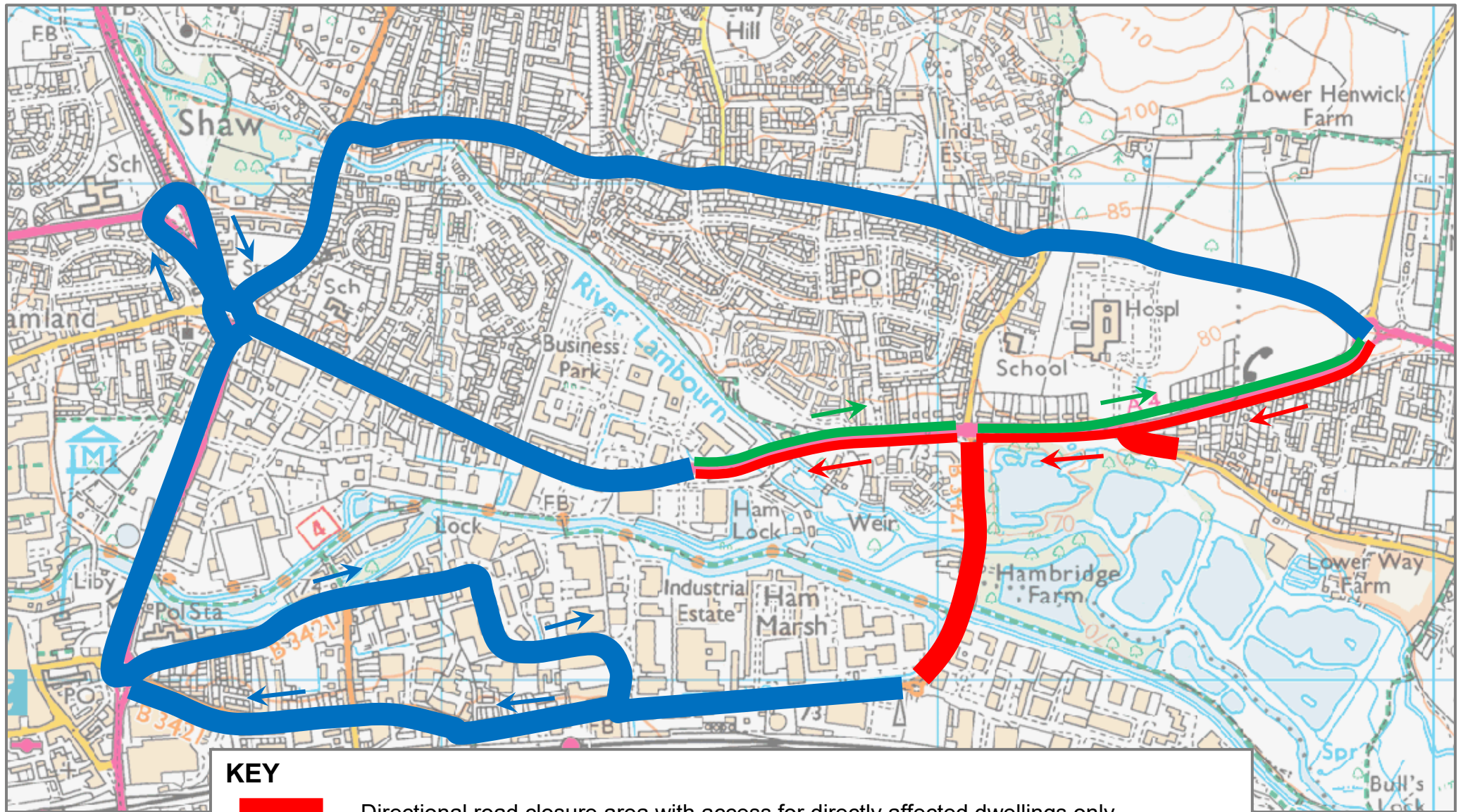


Road closure area with access for directly affected dwellings only via Racecourse roundabout.
